

Christmas Treasure Hunt

Clue 1

"Santa Claus" is the American pronunciation of the Dutch name for Saint Nicholas, what is the Dutch name?

Clue 2

Break this code to find the next clue:-

**wlanl oedakahg pqhjjet
nloapqfsp ieagk
nedeiosqet?**

tip: the code is a substitution code and uses the answer from Clue 1 as the 'key word' (if the key word has any double or repeated letters only use the first occurrence eg "moon" would be "mon")

To solve write out the alphabet in sequence like

so.... abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz

Then above this first write the "key word" eg if it was "moon" this is written as "mon" mon
abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz

Now carry on writing out the remaining letters of the alphabet in the sequence they occur alphabetically

monabcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz
abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz

Then work out what the code says look up the letter in the top row and write down the one below it in the bottom row. e.g. using the above code "hfk d" is the word "King" look up "h" in the top row and you'll see "k" is below it, etc...

Clue 4

The last two anagrams in Clue 3 tell you where to look to find the answer to this next question:
